### **Hollywood Freeway (US 101) Pavement Project from Downtown Los Angeles to Hollywood**

**LOS ANGELES** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue to re-pave lanes on US 101 Hollywood, Friday, November 6. Closures will occur on Friday and Saturday nights, and Sunday mornings. Motorists should expect delays and consider alternate routes.

#### Upcoming Closures:

Friday, January 15 to Sunday, January 18

Southbound US 101, Glendale Boulevard to SR-110

The timeframes for the closures are as follows:

Fridays and Saturdays:

Up to one lane – Midnight to 10 a.m.

Up to two lanes – Midnight to 9 a.m.

Up to three lanes – 1 a.m. to 7a.m.

Southbound US 101 to north- and southbound SR-110 connector – Midnight to 9 a.m.

Saturday and Sundays:

Up to one lane – Midnight to 11 p.m.

Up to two lanes – Midnight to 10 a.m.

Up to three lanes – 1 a.m. to 8 a.m.

Southbound US 101 to north- and southbound SR-110 connector – Midnight to 9 a.m.

Precast Jointed Concrete Pavement (PJCP) will be used at several locations within the project area. PJCP panels are cast and cured at a plant off-site and then trucked to the construction location and installed using a crane to help reduce closure times and maintenance costs.

This \$19.26 million project was awarded to OHL USA Inc. from Irvine, California. The project is funded by the State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) and is expected to finish by the end of 2016.

The California Highway Patrol will be on duty. Remember to **Be Work Zone Alert.**
