CLOSURES SCHEDULED ON THE HARBOR FREEWAY

GARDENA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close various lanes and ramps of the southbound Harbor Freeway (SR-110), between Dominguez Channel and 149th Street, nightly, Monday, March 28 through Friday, April 1, from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., due to grinding, paving, saw cutting, and slab replacement. At least one lane will be open at all times. The closures are:

Southbound SR-110:

Nightly, Monday, March 28 through Friday, April 1, from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m.

- Southbound SR-110 to San Diego Freeway (I-405) connector.

Nightly, Monday, March 28 through Friday, April 1, from 10 p.m. until 5 a.m.

- HOV lane (carpool) and up to four regular use lanes from 149th Street Overcrossing to 190th Street.

Nightly, Monday, March 28 through Friday, April 1, from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m.

- Southbound SR-110 to Artesia Freeway (SR-91) connector.

Replacement of damaged concrete will lead to a smoother and longer lasting roadway. Peterson Chase is the contractor. This project is expected to complete spring 2006.
