55-Hour Connector Closures Scheduled for I-10 HOV Project

Baldwin Park – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces two 55-hour weekend lane closures of the north- and southbound San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605) connectors to the eastbound San Bernardino Freeway (I-10) for pavement and drainage work. **The first closures begin this Friday, July 19 at 10 p.m.**

The 55-hour closures will occur as follows:

Friday, July 19 at 10 p.m. through Monday, July 22 at 5 a.m.

- Eastbound I-10 Frazier Street off-ramp
- Northbound I-605 to eastbound I-10 connector
- Southbound I-605 to eastbound I-10 connector

Friday, August 2 at 10 p.m. through Monday, August 5 at 5 a.m.

- Eastbound I-10 Frazier Street off-ramp
- Northbound I-605 to eastbound I-10 connector
- Southbound I-605 to eastbound I-10 connector

These closures are weather permitting and subject to change. Detour signs will be posted to direct motorists.

The 55 hour connector closures are part of the I-10 High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV or carpool) project. Flatiron West, Inc. is the contractor on this \$165 million project, which will add an HOV lane in each direction of I-10 between I-605 and Puente Avenue. Anticipated completion is summer, 2013.
