### Nightly Closures for I-5 Slab Replacement Project

*Los Angeles* — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the following lanes of the Golden State Freeway (I-5) as part of a \$10-million slab replacement project between the Foothill Freeway (I-210) and the Ronald Reagan Freeway (SR-118). Closures are subject to change.

#### Northbound Golden State Freeway (I-5) Closures

*Sunday, May 2, through Friday, May 7*

- Up to three lanes of I-5 between Paxton St. and San Fernando Mission Blvd.  
TIME: 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- I-5 HOV lane between Paxton St. and San Fernando Mission Blvd.  
TIME: 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

This \$10 million project will rehabilitate pavement in both directions of the project area, a total distance of nine miles (4.5 miles in each direction). Benefits include enhanced traffic flow through this segment of the freeway, a smoother ride for motorists, and extended pavement life. The project is scheduled to wrap up by the end of the year.
