## **LINCOLN BOULEVARD (SR-1) PAVEMENT REPAIRS AND AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) CURB UPGRADES**

**LOS ANGELES COUNTY** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of SR-1 from Sepulveda Boulevard to McConnell Avenue as part of a pavement rehabilitation project to enhance safety and mobility as well as upgrade existing curb ramps to ADA standards. Closure is as follows.

### **Sunday, October 28 through Tuesday, October 30**

#### **North- and Southbound SR-1**

- 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. –One lane in each direction will remain open during this operation.

Detours will be posted. New pavement will improve mobility and enhance safety for motorists. C. A. Rasmussen is the contractor on this \$1.13 million project which is expected to complete winter 2012.
