## CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

**LOS ANGELES** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. At least one lane will remain open to traffic at all times. The closures are as follows:

### Southbound I-5

#### Sunday, Night, May 6:

- 10:59 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to three lanes from SR-110 connector to North Broadway
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to three lanes from Glendale Boulevard to SR-2
- 10:59 p.m. to 4 a.m. – one lanes from Glendale Boulevard to Fletcher Drive

#### Monday, Night, May 7:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to three lanes from SR-2connector to SR-110 connector

#### Nightly, Sunday, May 6 through Tuesday, May 8:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to three lanes from Glendale Boulevard to SR-2 connector ramps
- 10:59 p.m. to 4 a.m. – one lanes from Glendale Boulevard to Fletcher Drive

### Northbound I-5

#### Nightly, Wednesday, May 9 and Thursday, May 10:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to three lanes from I-10 to SR-110 connector ramps
- 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. – State Street on-ramp
- 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Morengo Street on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – 4<sup>th</sup> Street on-ramps
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Cesar Chaves Avenue off-ramp
- 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. – up to three lanes from I-5 to Glendale Boulevard
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – one lane from SR-2 to Glendale Boulevard

### **Nightly, Wednesday, May 9 through Saturday, May 12:**

- 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. – State Street on-ramp
- 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Morengo Street on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – 4<sup>th</sup> Street on-ramps
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Cesar Chaves Avenue off-ramp

### **Westbound I-10**

### **Nightly, Wednesday, May 9 through Saturday, May 12:**

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – westbound I-10 connector to northbound I-5

The closures are in connection with the \$56 million pavement rehabilitation project on the I-5. FCI Constructors, Inc. is the contractor. Estimated completion date is winter 2010/2011. This project will replace damaged cement slab and grind or overlay the existing pavement in order to provide additional skid resistance and increase public safety.
