



installation of Hydroseed, re-installation of Compost, Fiber Rolls, rolled erosion control products (RECPs), straw mulching, straw incorporation, Silt Fence, night work, clean up, dust control (our straw mulching machines are retrofitted for dust suppression with the "Dust Dog" (United States Patent US 8,550,384 B2 (10/08/13)), costs of local licenses, permits, fees and/or other taxes, watering, pedestrian protection and traffic control.

- 6) Attorney fees and interest: If court action be instituted on this invoice, general contractor promises to pay reasonable attorney fees. A late payment charge of 1 1/2% per month will be charged on all invoices not paid within terms of quote. This is annual percentage rate of 18 %.
- 7) General Contractor to provide and pay for water source on jobsite (i.e., fire hydrant with valid water meter and/or water permit, 2,000 gallon capacity water truck, or other approved source at a minimum rate of 200 g.p.m. and/or at a minimum vertical height of 14 feet (for water towers or stands)). We'll require approximately 1,000 gallons of water for an estimated 6,000 SQFT of Hydromulch and an estimated 6,000 SQFT of Hydroseed. If water isn't made available on jobsite, this bid-proposal is invalid.
- 8) General Contractor to provide good, drivable truck access to each site to be treated with Hydromulch, with Hydroseed and with Compost.
- 9) Final field measured quantities shall be provided by General Contractor and/or Owners' Representative prior to installation of Hydromulch, of Hydroseed and of Compost.
