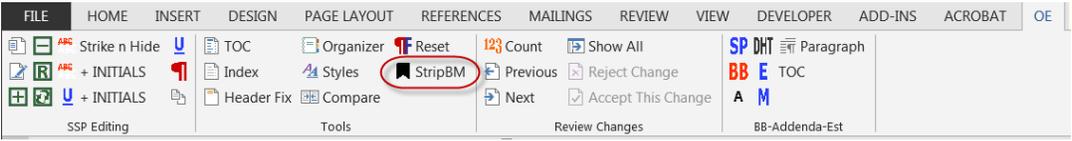
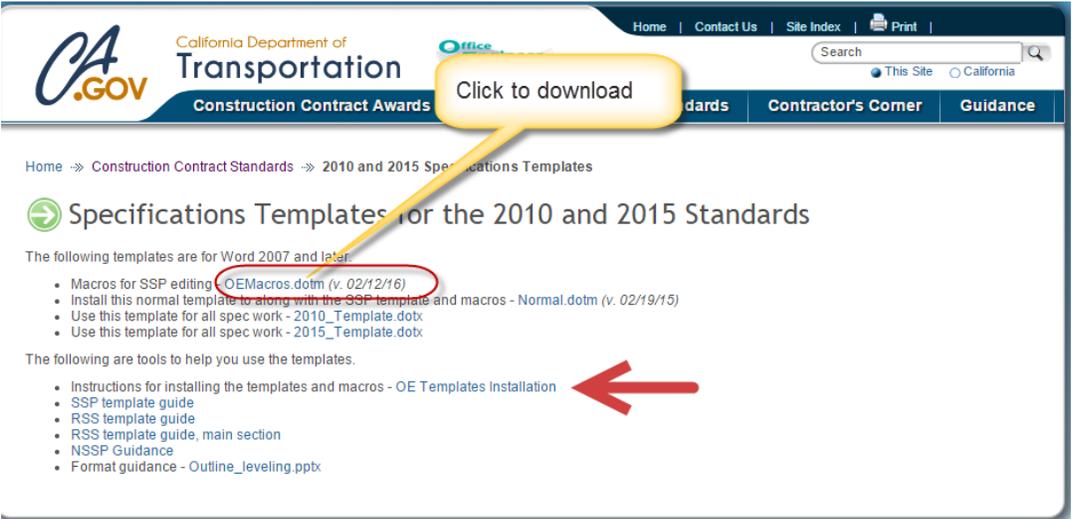


<p>What's new</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The new StripBM button in the OE tab; removes the hidden bookmarks. This is useful when working with large document. (See Issue 1)  <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. And the outline level that the table of contents macro brings in has been modified to accommodate the 2015 standards. (See Issue 2)

<p>Issue (FYI only)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In a large file, a high count of hidden bookmarks has resulted in the error message "There are too many edits in the document. This operation will be incomplete. Save your work." A common way hidden bookmarks are created is by inserting a table of contents. After the table of contents is removed, hidden bookmarks remain. If a document generates too many hidden bookmarks, that error message occurs. Click on the StripBM button and the macro removes the hidden bookmarks. 2. With the new 2015 standards here and available for projects, the outline level that the table of contents macro brings in needs to be changed so it only brings in Level 1. Levels 1-3 were required while the 2006 projects were around, but those contracts should now be completed and therefore, the macro can be changed to accommodate the 2015 standards. This change will work with 2010 standards too.
