OPTIONAL DISPOSAL SITE

SWA @ Mountain Gate Quarry, a privately owned commercial quarry, located off of I-5 (Wonderland/Fawndale Rd exit 689) on Radcliff Rd, approximately 3 miles south of the project location.

Facts stated herein are as known to the State of California, Caltrans, and are to be verified by the Contractor as per Section 6-2 of the Standard Specifications.

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General Information

Section 7-1.13 of the Standard Specifications applies to all of the project's disposal, including this site.

SWA @ Mountain Gate Quarry has agreed to accept material from the Turntable Bay Project; however, no formal arrangement has been made for the disposal of material at this private site. The contractor will need to make arrangements with the Manager of the Mountain Gate Quarry. The contractor is responsible for all liability, agreements, costs and fees associated with using this or any other site.

At the time of this handout, this site was listed on the SMARA 3098 list, as an active SMARA approved site.

The following information was confirmed by a telephone conversation on April 6, 2009 between Linda Garner, of Caltrans and Corkey, the Manager of the SWA @ Mountain Gate Quarry. Caltrans makes no guarantee that this policy would extend to a future agreement.

- The financial charge to dispose of rock, soil and concrete from this project shall be negotiated between the manager of the quarry and the contractor; the cost to the contractor will be less than the quarry's advertised fee schedule.
- Delivery of material will need to be coordinated with the quarry manager.
- Over 50% of the disposal material is expected to be rock. Based on this estimate, the manager has agreed to accept the rock, soil, and concrete (without metal).
- Disposal at this site is intended only for rock, concrete chunks, or earthen material and no steel or Naturally Occurring Asbestos material can be deposited at this site.
- The State assumes no liability for damage to contractor's equipment. No compensation will be made to the contractor for the handling of non-hazardous man-made material.

The contractor is encouraged to recycle loose steel at either the local landfill or commercial recyclers. In any case reinforcing steel becomes the property of the contractor.
