Addendum No. 4

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for CONSTRUCTION ON STATE HIGHWAY IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO FROM 1.3 MILE TO 0.3 MILE SOUTH OF THE ROUTE 101/1 SEPARATION.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on Friday, February 26, 2010. The Department will receive bids until 2:00 p.m. on the bid open date at 1120 N Street, Room 0200, MS 26, Sacramento, CA, 95814.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Notice to Bidders and Special Provisions, and provide a copy of the Information Handout.

In the Special Provisions, Section 5-1.15, "SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION," the following entry is added to the table:

In the Special Provisions, Section 5-1.28, "TUNNEL SAFETY ORDERS," the first paragraph is revised as follows:

"The work to be performed at the following locations: sign foundation piles and Southbound Battery Tunnel, has been classified "Potentially Gassy with Special Conditions" by the State Division of Occupational Safety and Health under Section 8422 of the Tunnel Safety Orders of the California Code of Regulations. The Special Conditions for sign foundation piles and Southbound Battery Tunnel are listed below:

1. A Certified Gas Tester shall perform pre-entry and continuous monitoring of the underground environment to measure Oxygen and detect explosive, flammable, and toxic gasses whenever an employee is working in the underground environment.
2. Mechanical ventilation shall provide for continuous exhaust of fumes and air at any time an employee is working in the underground environment. The primary ventilation fans must be located outside of the underground environment and shall be reversible by a single switch near the fan location.
3. The Division shall be notified immediately if any Flammable Gas or Petroleum Vapor exceeds 5% of the Lower Explosive Limit.
4. All utilities that may be in conflict with the project shall be identified and physically located (potholed) prior to the start of project operations."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.01, "ORDER OF WORK," the following paragraph is added after the fourteenth paragraph:

"The Contractor shall not begin Battery Substation (Bridge) construction until after the expiration of 150 working days after contract approval. Attention is directed to "Cooperation" elsewhere in these special provisions."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.83, "CONCRETE STRUCTURES," the following paragraph is added after the fourth paragraph:

"Completed roadway surfaces on all concrete structures, including the tunnel invert slab, shall conform to Section 51-1.17, "Finishing Bridge Decks," of the Standard Specifications."

Submit bids in the Bid book you now possess. Holders who have already mailed their book will be contacted to arrange for the return of their book.
