Hello Mr. Cook,

As per our conversation this morning, I am writing to confirm that we spoke about possible water sources for construction. We have two Caltrans Maintenance RHMA overlay projects on Amador Route 88.

1. 10-0V9004; Ama-88-PM 15.0/32.3
2. 10-0Y9404; Ama-88-PM 38.0/46.9

As part of our efforts to conserve water in the State, we have been directed to provide on all our projects a non-potable water source in an information handout as part of our projects PS&E packages.

This means that as the designer we need to check during design for a readily available non-potable water source 1<sup>st</sup> and if not possible potable water source that the contractor can select to use during construction. I have included a copy of our Caltrans Directive and Water Usage Guidance.

If I understand correctly from our conversation, Amador Water Agency has both non-potable and potable water sources for these two construction projects above.

The awarded contractor would need to contact Amador Water Agency at (209) 223-3018 or visit the main office at 12800 Ridge Road, Sutter Creek, Ca 95685 during working hours.

If this is correct for both these projects above and any project on State Routes in Amador County, please let me know. Also if you have any additional information you can include, please feel free. Once I hear back from you I will include this information in my PS&E Package.
